7. By this application, appellant/ petitioner seeks interim suspension of sentence and bail for a period of 30 days.

8. Per order dated 11.01.2021 the Jail Superintendent was directed to file correct nominal roll of the applicant herein. Yet again the nominal roll dated 22.03.2021 is filed which shows the period undergone by the accused



is two years, nine months and twenty five days and remission earned by him is nine months and eighteen days which comes out a total of three years and seven months approx, hence *the unexpired portion should be three years and five months.*

8. However the nominal roll on record shows the unexpired portion of sentence four years, four months and seventeen days which appears to be incorrect, and the same has not been explained by the Jail Superintendent despite an order passed by this Court on 11.01.2021.

9. In the circumstances, let the Jail Superintendent explain about how the unexpired portion of sentence of applicant is four years, four months and seventeen days as on 22.03.2021 if he has undergone sentence of two years, nine months and twenty five days with remission of nine months and eighteen days. The said reply be filed and placed on record, by the Jail Superintendent within a week from today.
