The Petitioner, a former employee of the Respondent Bank, seeks compliance of judgment dated 8th January, 2025 passed by a Division Bench of this Court in LPA No. 476/2013, whereby he was held entitled to voluntary retirement w.e.f. 13th July, 1998 with all consequential benefits.
