3. The present petition under Article 227 read with Article 21 of the Constitution of India, 1950, seeks the following prayers: -

“1. Issue direction for expeditious and time-bound adjudication of Guardianship Petition No. 91 of 2024 titled ‘*Varun Arora vs. Shruti Arora*’ pending before the Ld. Principal Judge, Family Court, South-West District, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi, preferably within a period of three (3) months or within such time as this Hon’ble Court may deem fit, in the paramount interest of the welfare and holistic development of the minor child.

2. Direct the Respondent not to obstruct, impede, or in any manner alienate the minor child from the love, care, and affection of the Petitioner, and to facilitate a healthy and respectful co-parenting arrangement.



3. Pass such other or further order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the present case, in the paramount interest, welfare, and wellbeing of the minor child."
4. Issue notice.
5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent accepts notice and refutes the contentions made in the present petition.
6. Without referring to the contents of the present petition and without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a request to the concerned learned Principal Judge, Family Court, South-West District, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi, to expedite the hearing of Guardianship Petition No. 91/2024 and decide the same as expeditiously as possible, without giving undue adjournments to either of the parties.
7. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
8. Copy of the order be sent to the concerned learned Principal Judge, Family Court, South-West District, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi, for necessary information and compliance.
