By way of the present petition filed under section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023, the petitioner seeks quashing of case FIR No. 522/2019 dated 15.07.2019 registered under sections 135/138/150 of Indian Electricity (Amendment) Act, 2003 at P.S.: New Usmanpur, Delhi.

The petition is based on a No Objection Certificate dated 05.02.2026 ('NOC') issued by the BSES (Yamuna Power Ltd.), whereby the dispute, which has arisen from the theft of electricity, has been settled.

The NOC narrates that respondent No.2 has settled the matter with the petitioner insofar as it is concerned with civil liability.

Mr. Sanjeet Trivedi, learned counsel has joined the proceedings via video-conferencing on behalf of respondent No.2/BSES. He confirms that the entire settlement amount has been received from the petitioner.

However, before proceeding further with the matter, respondent No.2 is directed to place on record a short affidavit, conveying their stand/no objection as to the quashing of the subject FIR.

Let all the parties remain present in court on the next date of hearing.
