3. By virtue of the present petition under *Article 226* of the Constitution of India read with *Section 528* of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, the petitioner seeks the following reliefs:-

“a) Issue a writ of ***mandamus*** or any other appropriate writ, order or direction to Respondents to register an FIR on the basis of the Petitioner's complaint dated 07.10.2025 and accompanying materials, in respect of cognizable offences including but not limited to Sections



381, 70(1), 74, 75, 308(2), 308(3), 79, 61(2) BNS (306, 376D, 354, 354-A, 384, 385, 509, 120-B IPC) and other allied provisions, against accused persons found to be involved.

b) Direct transfer of investigation to a specialized and independent agency such as Crime Branch/SIT/any other agency deemed fit by this Hon'ble Court, with further direction to conduct fair, impartial and time-bound investigation, including: seizure and forensic examination of all mobiles, pen-drive, CDRs, social media accounts, hotel records and property documents referred in the complaint; recording of statements of Petitioner, minor son, Shubham and other witnesses; and collection of all suicide/ dying declaration videos and their transcripts.

c) Direct Respondent-State to provide adequate **protection** to the Petitioner, his minor son and key witness Shubham Singhal from threats, coercion and false implication.

d) Direct Respondent-State to consider interim and final compensation to the Petitioner and his minor son under the Victim Compensation Scheme/Section 396 BNSS (357-A Cr.P.C.) and other applicable schemes.

e) Call for the original record of SDM proceedings, inquest report and PCR call records made by deceased S in days preceding her death , and direct that the same be incorporated in the fresh investigation ”

4. Issue notice.

5. Learned ASC accepts notice. She seeks and, is granted, a period of two weeks for filing the Status Report.

6. Renotify on 06.05.2026.
