1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking following reliefs:

- “i. Issue a Writ of Mandamus or other appropriate writ directing the Respondent to remove all illegal encroachments and unauthorized constructions, whether permanent or temporary, on the public road, footpaths and public land in the area of Shaani Bazaar, Hastal Road, Ward Nos. 107 and 108, Uttam Nagar, New Delhi;*
- ii. Issue a Writ of Mandamus or other appropriate writ directing the Respondent to ensure that the public road, footpaths and drainage systems in the said area are restored to their original condition and kept free from any illegal encroachments or obstructions; and”*

2. It is stated that the petitioner had raised a complaint before the Public Grievances Commission which had made recommendations on 16th April,



2025 and 5th June, 2025, calling upon the officials of MCD to take necessary action.

3. The grievance of the petitioner is that no action has been taken despite various complaints filed by the petitioner as well as recommendations of the Public Grievances Commission.

4. Photographs have been filed along with the petition showing the encroachment.
