1. Matter is listed for ex-parte evidence.
2. Defendant no. 2, 6 to 11 already stands deleted.
3. Suit stands decreed qua defendant no.3 & defendant no. 4.
4. Defendant no. 12 is ex-parte.
5. Perusal of record shows that status of defendant no.1 is not clear. Though defendant no. 1 is mentioned as John Doe in order dated 05.4.2024, the email and other details of defendant no.1 are mentioned in amended memo of parties. Ld. Counsel for plaintiff confirms the same and seeks some time to apprise the court about the service status of defendant no.1.
6. A perusal of record shows that previous orders do not mention about the service status of defendant no.5 and completion of pleadings qua defendant no.5. The affidavit of service of plaintiff is on record, as per which, defendant no.5 has been served through email on 27.03.2024. However, no written statement has been filed by defendant no.5 within the maximum permissible



period of 120 days. Hence, the right of defendant no.5 to file written statement stands closed.

7. The plaintiff has not filed ex-parte evidence affidavit of the Plaintiff's witness. Ld. Counsel for plaintiff seeks some more time to file ex-parte evidence affidavit. Plaintiffs are directed to file their ex-parte evidence affidavit within six weeks.

8. Put up for reporting of status of defendant no.1 /ex-parte evidence on 13.07.2026.
