1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner submits that the issue raised in the present petition has already been decided by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *All Manipur Pensioners Association Vs. State of Manipur and Others* (2020) 14 SCC 625.

2. On the other hand, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents submits that the petitioner in the present petition has claimed that the PPO may be issued as per recommendations of 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission pursuant to order dated 03.08.2016 passed in W.P (C) 3035/2016 along with all consequential benefits and arrears. Learned counsel for respondents further informs that Special Leave Petition against the order dated 03.08.2016 is pending adjudication before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and is likely to be listed in July, 2022.

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3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that when the aforesaid Special Leave Petition came up for hearing, the Hon'ble Supreme Court raised a query to the respondents as to what remains in the present petition pursuant to decision in *All Manipur Pensioners Association Vs. State of Manipur and Others*.

4. Since the Special Leave Petition against the order dated 03.08.2016 in W.P (C) 3035/2016 is likely to be listed in July, 2022, based upon which the present petition has been filed, the petition is adjourned.
