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1. The present Petition has been filed under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, seeking appointment of an Arbitrator to adjudicate upon the disputes between the Parties under an Agreement dated 23.09.2025, executed between the parties for payroll management services in respect of manpower deployed at various Central Government Offices in Delhi-NCR (*hereinafter referred to as "Agreement"*).

2. Under the Agreement, the Petitioner was to provide payroll services for Data Entry Operators, Accounts Assistants, MTS and official staff of the Respondent.

3. It is stated that disputes arose between the parties since the Respondent failed to make payments towards the invoices raised by the Petitioner.

4. Clause 14 of the Agreement contains an arbitration clause and Clause



17 of the Agreement specifically states that the Courts of Delhi will have the jurisdiction to entertain the dispute arising between the parties.

5. It is stated that since the Respondent failed to honour their commitments, a notice under Section 21 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 invoking arbitration was sent to the Respondent on 13.01.2026. It is stated that since no reply to the said notice was received from the Respondent, the present Petition has been filed by the Petitioner.

6. Issue notice.

7. On taking steps, let notice be issued to the Respondent through all permissible modes, including *dasti*.
