I.A. 5908/2025 (exemption)

1. Plaintiff shall file legible/original/certified and clearer copies of exempted documents, in compliance with practice rules, before the next date of hearing.
2. The application for exemption is allowed, subject to the plaintiff granting inspection of the documents filed, as and when required to do so, or filing the original documents at the stage of admission/denial.
3. The application stands disposed of.

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4. The plaint be registered as a suit. Issue summons. Mr. Udaibir Singh Kochar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of defendant No.1, is present. He confirms the receipt of the suit paperbook and waives the right of formal service of summons.



5. Summons be issued to defendant No.2 by all permissible modes on filing of process fee. Affidavit of service be filed within two weeks.
6. The summons shall indicate that written statements must be filed within thirty days from the date of receipt of summons. The defendants shall also file affidavits of admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiff, failing which the written statements shall not be taken on record.
7. The plaintiff is at liberty to file replications thereto within thirty days after filing of the written statements. The replications shall be accompanied by affidavits of admission/denial in respect of the documents filed by the defendants, failing which the replications shall not be taken on record.
8. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.
9. Any party seeking inspection of documents may do so in accordance with the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.
10. List before the learned Joint Registrar for completion of service and pleadings, marking of exhibits and admission/denial of documents on 08.09.2025.

I.A. 5911/2025 (exemption from serving defendants notice on I.A. 5907/2025)

11. For the reasons stated in the application, the court is not inclined to grant the same. Accordingly, the instant application stands rejected.

14. Learned counsel appearing for defendant No.1 accepts notice. He shall be at liberty to file a reply within four weeks from today.
