1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.

CM APPL.11528/2024 (for recalling of order 12th April, 2023)

2. This matter has been received after transfer.

3. The present application on behalf of the Petitioner seeks recall of directions in paragraph 10 of the order dated 12th April, 2023. The relevant part of the order is hereinbelow:

“10. It is directed that none of the parties shall proceed further any criminal complaints or other cases which they may have filed against each other before any forum, Tribunal or authority. If the mediator deems it necessary, caucus hearings, may also be held only between the husband and the wife i.e. Respondent Nos. 4 and 5”

4. In the said order dated 12th April, 2023, considering the facts prevalent on the said date, the Court had deemed it appropriate to refer the matter to the mediation since a minor child is involved.

5. Ld. Counsel for the Applicant today submits that the meditation has



failed. In this view, the matter would have to be heard on merits. Ld. counsel submits that he does not seek review of the order dated 12th April, 2023 but vacation of the said order.

6. Accordingly, this matter be placed before the Roster Bench on 12th March, 2024 for consideration on merits as to whether the interim order deserves to be continued.
