1. The present writ petition has been filed seeing the following reliefs:-



- (i) to remove illegal parking of the vehicles from the public land, streets and passages etc. in the area of Ashok Vihar, Phase-I, New Delhi and/or nearby area to it and for taking strict legal action against the offenders/ wrong doers;
- (ii). to direct the respondents especially the respondent no.3 MCD to permit the residents of the area of Ashok Vihar, Phase-I, New Delhi to get installed the gate on the entry of the gali/passage to stop the entry of unwanted anti-social elements in the area in order to curb the incidents such as theft in houses, snatching etc.
- iii). to direct the respondents especially the respondent no.3 MCD to provide parking space in the above said area in order to make permanent solution of illegal parking in the said area either at the space available with it or at the space /land available with the D.D.A.;
- iv) to direct the respondents to make arrangement for easy access in the area of Ashok Vihar, Phase-I, New Delhi and/or nearby area to the emergency vehicles, fire brigade and ambulances etc. in case of any need or emergency or as and when required without any let or hindrance.
- v) to direct the respondents, especially the police authorities to make arrangement of one way system in the area of Ashok Vihar, Phase-I, New Delhi in order to unease the traffic jam and other traffic problems;

for smooth traffic movements.
