Matter is taken up through physical hearing as well as video conferencing.

Defendants no.1 and 3 stands served on 05.05.2026, whereas defendant no.2 is unserved with the report 'residing out of India'. Ld. Counsel for plaintiff states that he had received mail from Ld. Counsel for defendant no.1 and 3 that certain documents are not legible.

Counsel for plaintiff undertakes to supply the same to Ld. Counsel for defendant no.1 and 3 with true typed copies of the same.

Be fixed for completion of pleadings on 08.10.2026. Interim order if any to continue.
