1. By order dated 25.03.2026, the captioned petition was disposed of,
by which it was directed as under:

“The petitioner, who stands convicted of an offence under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, is presently undergoing a sentence of life imprisonment and has already completed more than 15 years of actual incarceration. He is currently lodged in Central Jail No. 14, Mandoli, New Delhi.

2. The petitioner has preferred an application seeking parole for three months to complete the construction of his house, and is aggrieved by the fact that the said application has not elicited any response from the concerned authorities.

3. Mr. Yasir Rauf Ansari, learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State, who appears on advance notice, submits that the petitioner's application shall be considered and decided within a period of two weeks from today, and that the decision thereon shall be communicated to the petitioner.

4. In view of the aforesaid submission, the present petition is disposed of, without prejudice to the rights and remedies available to the



parties, in accordance with law.”

2. The petitioner has filed this application stating that the order has not been complied with and no decision has been communicated to the petitioner.
3. The Principal Secretary, Home Department, Government of NCT Delhi, is directed to file an affidavit dealing the petitioner's request on merits, and also stating as to why the order dated 25.03.2026 has not been complied with.
