CRL.M.A. 16712/2026 (*for release on parole*)

1. By way of the present application, the applicant – petitioner seeks directions to the respondent to release him on parole for a period of three months.
2. Pursuant to the order dated 22.05.2026, Mr. Yasir Rauf Ansari, learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State, has handed over an affidavit of the Principal Secretary (Home), Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi, dated 06.07.2026, explaining non-compliance of the order dated 25.03.2026, by which the petition was disposed of. The same is taken on record.
3. It appears from the affidavit that the petitioner's case was not



reflected in the “*e-Parole Module*” due to a technical issue. It has also been stated that best efforts are being made to resolve the technical issues in the module with the assistance of National Informatics Centre, Delhi Prisons. A new version of the module has now been developed. It is also stated that a Standard Operating Procedure to ensure expeditious disposal of parole applications has already been developed, pursuant to directions dated 01.04.2026 in W.P.(CRL.) 618/2026 [*Nandu @ Ram Kishore v. State (NCT of Delhi)*].

4. In view of the above, the explanation for delay is accepted.
5. Mr. Ansari states that the petitioner’s case has been considered on merits, and rejected by order dated 06.07.2026. By the order dated 25.03.2026, the rights and remedies of the petitioner were reserved.
6. The application is, therefore, disposed of, without prejudice to the remedies of the petitioner against the order dated 06.07.2026.
