IA No.45464/2024 under Order XXII Rule 2&4 CPC moved by the plaintiff to bring on record the LRs of D-2

Learned counsel for the defendants who is also representing LRs of D-2 submits that he will file his Vakalatnama on behalf of proposed two LRs (LR nos. b & c) of deceased defendant no.2 shortly. Let needful be done as stated. He further submits that he has no objection to the captioned IA.

Heard. As per the captioned IA, the defendant no.2 has expired on 21.09.2024 leaving behind three legal heirs. It is stated that LR no.(a) is the wife of deceased defendant no.2 and she is already impleaded as defendant no.4 in the present matter. The right to sue survives against LRs of deceased defendant no.2. It is also stated in the captioned IA that there are no other legal heirs of deceased defendant no.2. Further, the captioned IA has been filed within time.

In view of the aforesaid, the captioned IA stands allowed to the extent that all legal heirs no.(b) & (c) of deceased defendant no.2 are allowed to be substituted in



place of deceased defendant no.2 and requisite entry be made in respect of LR no.(a) of deceased defendant no.2. The plaintiff is directed to file Amended Memo of Parties within two weeks with copy to the opposite side. Accordingly, the captioned IA stands disposed of.
