W.P.(CRL) 963/2026

By way of the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks release on cash surety in-lieu of surety bond to avail second spell of furlough that was granted to him *vide* order dated 30.12.2025 by the jail authorities.

2. Mr. Yugansh Mittal, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits, that on earlier occasions the petitioner's sister has stood surety for him but now she has relocated to her hometown in District Azamgarh, Uttar Pradesh; and there is no one who is willing to stand surety for him in Delhi.



3. After a brief hearing in the matter, this court is not inclined to allow the present petition.
4. The petition is accordingly dismissed; however granting liberty to the petitioner to arrange appropriate surety to avail the furlough granted to him *vide* order dated 30.12.2025.
5. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed-of.
