This petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of the FIR bearing no. 188/2019, registered under Section 498A/406/34 IPC & at P.S. Anand Vihar, Delhi, and all proceedings emanating therefrom.

It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioners that petitioner no.1 and respondent no.2 got married on 22.3.2007 and lived together till 2009 as the respondent no.2 left her matrimonial home in the month of May, 2009. It is further submitted by the counsel for the petitioner that after 12 years of leaving the matrimonial home, the complainant has filed the present FIR as a counterblast to the divorce proceedings filed by petitioner no.1.
