1. Heard the learned counsel for the parties. This application has been filed on behalf of respondent No.3/ Heritage Conservation Committee for modification of our order dated 25.03.2026.
2. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, paragraph 8 and 9 of the said order dated 25.03.2026 is modified which shall now be read as under:

*“Be that as it may, having regard to the oral facts and circumstances of the case, we permit the Petitioners to approach the competent authority, namely, Heritage Conservation Committee qua ventilation of their grievances by way of making a fresh representation taking all the pleas, which*



*will be available to the Petitioners and enclosing thereto all the documents, on which they intend to rely on. Simultaneously, the petitioner shall also make a representation to the Municipal Corporation of Delhi who, thereafter, shall make appropriate proposal to the Heritage Conservation Committee seeking its advice/ recommendation. The MCD shall, once any such representation is made, consider the matter within eight weeks from the date the representation under this Order is made and refer the same to the Heritage Conservation Committee for appropriate advice/ recommendation. The Heritage Conservation Committee shall, thereafter, consider the matter within four weeks and tender its advice/ recommendation based on which appropriate decision shall be taken by the MCD/ Government of Delhi.*

3. Paragraph 9 of the order dated 25.03.2026 shall stand deleted.
4. The application stands disposed of accordingly.
