3. This writ petition has been filed with the following prayers: -

“(i) issue a writ of Certiorari or any other appropriate Writ, Order or Direction to quash and set aside the impugned Orders viz. the final Order dated 17.09.2024, passed by the Disciplinary Authority, the Order dated 20.11.2024, passed by the Appellate Authority and the Order dated 23.01.2025, passed by the Revisional Authority.

(ii) issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, thereby directing/commanding the Respondents to expunge the punishment Order and all adverse entries from the service record of the Petitioner.

(iii) issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, thereby directing/commanding the Respondents to restore the pay of the Petitioner to Rs.34,900/- in Pay Matrix Level-5 with immediate effect.



(iv) issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, thereby directing/commanding the Respondents to grant all consequential service benefits to the Petitioner, including arrears of pay, increments, and all other benefits that have been denied due to the impugned punishment order.

(v) issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, thereby directing/commanding the Respondents to treat the period of suspension (09.01.2024 to 08.03.2024) as duty period for all purposes and grant full pay and allowances for the said period.

(vi) award costs of the present Original Application in favor of the Petitioner.

(vii) pass any other or further order(s) as this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case in the interest of justice and equity.”

4. Issue notice. Mr. Chiranjiv Kumar, Advocate accepts notice.
5. Counter-affidavit be filed within eight weeks. Rejoinder be filed within four weeks thereafter.
6. At the outset, learned counsel for the respondents says that the designation of the writ petitioner must be read as Inspector Executive wherever is mentioned in this writ petition. The submission is taken on record.
7. Renotify before the Registrar for completion of pleadings on 08.07.2026.
