1. The hearing has been conducted through Video Conferencing.

Crl.M.A.No.3551/2021

2. By this application, appellants/applicants seek delay condonation of three days in filing the appeal.

3. In view of the reasons so explained, the delay of three days in filing the appeal stands condoned.

5. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

CRL.A. 108/2021

7. Per judgment dated 20.12.2021 passed by the learned Trial Court in Session's Case No.379/2017 arising out of the FIR No.1636/2015 under Section 308/34 IPC registered at police station Neb Sarai, the appellants have been convicted under Section 149 and 308 read with Section 149 IPC.



Per order on sentence dated 08.01.2021, the appellants were sentenced to RI for two years each with fine of Rs.15,000/- each. Both the sentences to run concurrently. Fine has already been deposited. The benefit of Section 428 Cr P C was also extended.

11. By this application, the appellants/petitioners seek regular suspension of sentence and bail during the pendency of appeal.
