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1. While CRL.A. 108/2021 and CRL.A. 110/2021 have been preferred by the appellants challenging their conviction under Section 149 read with Section 308 IPC, CRL.A. 124/2021 has been preferred by the complainant seeking alteration of conviction from Section 308 IPC to 307 IPC.
2. At this stage, learned counsel appearing for appellant/Kamal Sharma in CRL.A. 108/2021 submits that there was a cross FIR in which the complainant was acquitted and the appellant has assailed the same vide separate CRL.
