1. By way of present application, the appellant No.2/Jayant Sharma@ Jayendra seeks release of his passport.
2. Learned counsel for appellant No.2/Jayant Sharma@ Jayendra submits that at the time of passing of the order on suspension of sentence, no condition was imposed for depositing of passport. In this regard, learned counsel has also relied on Maneka Gandhi v. Union of India¹, and Suresh Nanda v. CBI². He further submits that he would file an undertaking in the form of an affidavit of the appellant and before undertaking any travel, he would seek prior permission of the concerned Court.
