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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeks following prayers:-

“a. SET ASIDE OR STAY the coercive execution direction contained in the order dated 13.02.2026 passed by the Learned Family Court, Saket, New Delhi in execution proceedings arising out of HMA No. 1353/2023;
b. STAY issuance of warrant of arrest or any coercive execution proceedings against the Petitioner pursuant to the impugned order;
c. PERMIT the Petitioner to continue depositing interim maintenance at a reasonable amount as may be directed by this Hon'ble Court without prejudice to his rights and contentions in the pending Review Application;
d. DIRECT expeditious disposal of the Review Application pending before the Ld. Family Court;
e. PASS such other or further order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”



3. It is brought to the notice of this Court that the petitioner has challenged the order granting maintenance dated 17.10.2025 as well as order dated 19.02.2026 in respect of review petition filed for the aforesaid order by way of petition bearing no. MAT.APP.(F.C.) 102/2026, which is listed before the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court today itself.
4. In these circumstances, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to move appropriate application seeking similar reliefs in the aforesaid appeal.
5. Leave and liberty granted.
6. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.
7. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
8. Let an appropriate application be filed before the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court within a period of one week from today. Till the filing of the said application, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner.
