1. The present petition alleges wilful disobedience of the directions contained in the judgment / order dated 29.07.2025 passed in W.P.(C) 1744/2016 and W.P.(C) 10546/2023. The operative directions passed therein are as under:

“25. In that view of the matter, we deem it appropriate to allow both these writ petitions with directions to the respondents to re-assess the amount of compensation payable to the petitioners under all heads under the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land, Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013.

26. Let the entire exercise of determining the compensation payable to the petitioners in regard to the land to the extent of the petitioners only acquired by the respondents be completed within a period of six months from today.”



2. Issue notice.
3. Learned counsel, as aforesaid, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
4. The respondents are directed to expeditiously comply with the aforesaid directions. Let a reply / compliance affidavit be filed within a period of four weeks from today.
