1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

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3. The present appeal preferred by the insurer seeks to assail the award dated 13.01.2023 passed by the learned MACT.
4. Upon the appellant taking steps, issue notice to respondent nos. 2 to 4 through all permissible modes. Notice need not be issued to respondent no. 1 as she is stated to have expired leaving behind only respondent nos. 2 & 3 as her legal heirs, who have already been arrayed as respondents in the appeal. Furthermore, no notice is required to be issued to respondent nos. 5 & 6 as no recovery rights have been granted against them under the impugned award.
5. List on 22.09.2023.



6. In the meanwhile, let the LCR be requisitioned and digitized before the next date.

CM APPL. 16260/2023 -Stay.

7. This is an application seeking stay of the impugned award. The application is disposed of by directing the appellant to deposit, within six weeks, 70% of the awarded amount with the learned Tribunal with a further direction to the learned Tribunal to release the same in favour of the claimants as per the scheme of disbursal contained in the impugned award.
8. Subject to the appellant depositing the amount in terms of this order, the operation of the impugned award will remain stayed.
9. The application is, accordingly, disposed of.
