1. This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayers:-

“a. Issue an appropriate writ/order/direction thereby setting aside/quashing the closure of the Petitioner's complaint dated 05.02.2026 by the RBI Integrated Ombudsman under Clause 16(2)(a) of the RB-IOs, 2021 and direct adjudication on merits;

b. Issue an appropriate writ/order/direction thereby directing Respondent No. 1 to reverse the disputed fraudulent transactions amounting to ₹96,740/- and all related interest, charges and penalties, and to issue written confirmation of zero liability of the Petitioner;

c. Issue an appropriate writ/order/direction thereby directing Respondent No. 1 to cease and desist from all recovery calls, coercive communications, and demands relating to the disputed transactions during pendency of the present petition;



d. Issue an appropriate writ/order/direction thereby restraining Respondent No. 1 to report to credit bureau during pendency

e. Direct Respondent No. 1 to furnish complete technical and documentary details relating to the alleged issuance and activation of the disputed credit card, including but not limited to:

(i) the specific IP address and device particulars used for activation of the card;

(ii) the exact activation date and time stamp recorded in the system logs;

(iv) the complete proof of delivery, including courier receipt, signed acknowledgment, GPS-based delivery tracking record; and

(v) identification details and KYC credentials of the delivery agent who purportedly attempted or effected delivery of the said card....”

2. Mr. Uban, learned counsel for the petitioner, states amongst other grounds, that the order suffers from non-application of mind and is in violation of principles of natural justice.
3. For the said reasons, issue notice to the respondents through all modes including electronic on the petitioner taking steps within one week from today, returnable on 10.08.2026.
