2. For the reasons stated in the application, which is duly supported by affidavit, the application is allowed.
3. The appellant is exempted from filing lengthy synopsis and list of dates.

8. The appellant impugns judgment dated 26.12.2025 and sentencing order dated 12.01.2026.
9. Learned counsel appearing for the appellant submits, that the petitioner company was sentenced to a fine of Rs.25,00,000/- for the offences under sections 120-B/420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC'); and to a fine of another sum of Rs.25,00,000/- for the offence under section 420 of IPC. Counsel submits that as recorded in order dated 05.02.2026 passed by the learned trial court, the entire fine of Rs.50,00,000/- has been deposited by way of two demand drafts.
