CRL.M.A. 9379/2026 (*Interim bail*)

1. By virtue of the present application, the petitioner seeks interim bail from 27.03.2026 to 05.04.2026 on account of his niece's marriage.
2. After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present application.
3. The present application is dismissed as withdrawn.

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4. By virtue of the present petition under Section 422 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, the petitioner *inter alia* seeks the



following reliefs:

“(a) Call for the trial court record in the above matter;

(b) Set aside the Judgment dated 09.03.2026 passed by the Court of Addl. Sessions Judge (FTC-0 1), South District, Saket Courts, New Delhi in CA No. 561/2025, and set aside the judgment dated 24.05.2025 and the Order on Point of Sentence dated 06.10.2025 passed by the Trial Court (JMFC Mahila Court-02, Saket Courts, New Delhi) in FIR No. 02/2021, U/S. 354/354A IPC, P.S. INA Metro, and ACQUIT the Petitioner of all charges;

(c) Alternatively, in the event this Hon'ble Court does not acquit the Petitioner, reduce the sentence to the period already undergone in judicial custody;”

5. Issue notice.
6. Learned APP for the State accepts notice. He seeks, and is granted, a period of *four weeks* for filing the Status Report.
7. Let the Nominal Roll be also requisitioned from the concerned Jail Superintendent within the aforesaid period of *two weeks*.
8. Let TCR be requisitioned in the digitised form from the learned Trial Court within a period of *four weeks*.
9. A copy of this order be sent to the concerned Jail Superintendent.
10. Renotify on 05.05.2026.
