IA 771/2023 (for extension of time)

1. This matter was called out twice, but there is no appearance on behalf of the plaintiff.

2. This is an application by Defendant 1 seeking extension of time to comply with the direction contained in para 24(iv) of the order dated 2nd August 2022.

3. The order dated 2nd August 2022 required the defendants to pay ₹ 75 lakhs as costs, of which ₹ 30 lakhs were to be paid to the plaintiff on or before 15th September 2022, ₹ 25 lakhs were to be paid to the Prime Minister's National Relief Funds on or before 15th November 2022 and ₹ 20 lakhs were to be deposited with the Registrar General of this Court on or before 15th January 2023.

4. Mr. Sultan, learned Counsel for the defendants, submits that the



first two instalments have been paid within time, but seeks three months to comply with the requirement of paying ₹ 20 lakhs on the ground of financial stringency.

5. As there has been substantial compliance with the direction for payment as contained in para 24(iv) of the order dated 2nd August 2022, the time for payment of the third instalment of ₹ 20 lakhs shall stand extended till 17th March 2023. It is made clear that no further extension on this count shall be granted.

6. This application stands allowed to the aforesaid extent.
