1. This appeal has been filed assailing impugned judgment dated 20th December 2025 passed by Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal [*MACT/Tribunal*], South East District, Saket Court, New Delhi in MACT No.231/2019, whereby, the claim petition of appellant was dismissed.
2. *Mr. A K Mishra*, counsel for appellant/claimant, contends that the MACT did not take into account that negligence was alleged against owner of vehicle bearing registration no *DL-14CD-0275* (hereinafter, '*offending vehicle*') with which the collision had happened, while appellant/claimant was driving vehicle bearing registration no. *UP-32HK-0402*.
3. He states that, at the very best, once a case had been registered against owner of offending vehicle, the factum of injuries suffered by appellant/claimant in the accident could not be doubted.
4. Accordingly, issue notice.
5. *Mr. Aditya Kumar*, counsel for Insurance Company, accepts notice.
6. On appellant taking steps, notice be issued to respondents, through all



permissible modes, returnable on 14th October 2026.
