Pursuant to the order dated October 24, 2019, compliance affidavit has been filed by the decree holder, judgment debtor No.1 as well as the purchaser. The only issue raised by the learned counsel for the parties, including Mr. Chaturvedi, learned counsel appearing for the decree holder is with regard to the claim of 2.23% of the share holding.

Mr. Chaturvedi also states that the amount equivalent to 2.23% of the share holding is ₹8,68,37,063/- and, the said amount has been deposited in the Registry of this Court by way of a demand draft drawn in favour of the Registrar General on October 30, 2019.



If that be so, the said amount shall be kept in FDR with periodical renewals till further orders. On this issue, learned counsel for the judgment debtor No.1 seeks and is allowed two weeks to file additional documents by way of an affidavit. Liberty is with the decree holder to file reply to the same within two weeks thereafter.

I take on record the statement made by the learned counsel for the judgment debtor No.1 that the cost as imposed by this Court vide order dated October 21, 2019 shall be deposited in terms of that order within one week from today.
