E.A. 68/2021 and E.A. 69/2021 (Under Section 151 CPC filed by JD1 seeking Condonation of Delay)

1. The present applications have been filed under Section 151 CPC on behalf of the Judgment Debtor No.1 seeking condonation of delay of 295 days in filing the sur-rejoinder and reply to CRL. M.A. 439/2020 respectively.
2. It has been stated in the applications that applicant/Judgment Debtor No.1 is about 82 years of age. She was undergoing kidney dialysis and thus was in strict isolation. Learned counsel for judgment debtor submits that on account of applicant's old age as well as the lockdown imposed on account



of COVID-19 pandemic, the sur-rejoinder and reply to CRL. M.A. 439/2020 could not be filed in time.

3. Mr. Amitabh Chaturvedi, learned counsel appearing for the decree holder fairly submits that he has no objection to the applications being allowed.

4. For the reasons stated in the applications, the delay of 295 days in filing the sur-rejoinder and reply to CRL. M.A. 439/2020 respectively is condoned and the applications are allowed.

5. The applications stand disposed of.

1. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, be filed within two weeks with an advance copy to the other side.

2. List on the *en-bloc* date i.e., on 08.03.2021.

3. In the meantime, synopsis not exceeding five pages be filed with an advance copy thereof to the other side.
