1. Without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the petitioners in these petitions, Mr. Sajal Dhamija, learned counsel for the petitioners, submits that one of the issues raised in the status report filed by the State in CRL.M.C. 5153/2026 concerns the conduct of petitioner No. 1 in failing to surrender within the time granted by the Supreme Court, upon setting aside of an order of anticipatory bail granted to him. Mr. Dhamija states that petitioner No. 1 has voluntarily affirmed an affidavit/undertaking of apology, which he would like to place on record.
2. Mr. Dhamija also submits that the petitioners are agreeable to any such conditions by way of costs or otherwise, as this Court would consider appropriate. To show their *bonafide*, the petitioners have prepared a demand draft in the sum of Rs. 15,00,000/-, in favour of the Registrar General of this Court towards such costs, as the Court may consider fit to impose. He further submits that the petitioners have also prepared a demand draft of Rs. 2.35 crores, which has been handed over



to Mr. Kunal Malhotra, learned counsel for the complainant, being the remaining amount towards payment of the settlement amount of Rs. 3.7 crores, provided in the Settlement Deed dated 12.06.2026 between the parties.

3. The petitioners are permitted to place the aforesaid affidavit on record, and to deposit the demand draft of Rs. 15,00,000/- with the Registrar General of this Court, without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the parties.

4. The latest Nominal Roll of the petitioner in BAIL APPLN. 2886/2026 be called for from the concerned Jail Superintendent, and be placed on record before the next date of hearing.
