1. In terms of the previous order, learned counsel for respondent No.1 submitted that she has inspected the file which revealed that the share of the respondent No.1 in the deposited amount, which is directed to be released against security, is Rs.16,56,612/- being the principal amount and Rs.6,68,175/- being the interest accrued on the aforesaid principal amount, which is lying deposited in the form of FDR. She further submitted that as per order of the Hon'ble Court dated 01.08.2025, respondent No.1 is required to furnish security for the principal amount and there is no direction for giving the security on the accrued interest amount.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent No.1 further submitted that for the release of the aforesaid amount in terms of order dated 01.08.2025 passed by the Hon'ble Court, respondent No.1 has e-filed security bond alongwith the



copy of the TDR bearing No.8195394821 dated 04.12.2025 for Rs.17,00,000/- issued by Indian Bank, Janakpuri, C Block Branch, Delhi in favour of Mr. Rajpal Singh.

3. In view of the above, let court notice be issued to the Branch Manager of the concerned bank with the direction to appear alongwith authorization given by the bank in his favour and submit report in respect of the verification and genuineness of the aforesaid TDR and also confirm the following:-

- (i) Name of the person/firm in whose favour the TDR has been issued and whether the same is alive in the bank records or not.
- (ii) Whether there is any lien or charge on the same and whether any loan and advance has been taken against the same.
- (iii) Whether the same is on auto-renewal mode.
- (iv) Whether any duplicate copy has been issued in respect of the same.

4. The registry is directed to mention in the court notice that the concerned Branch Manager is at liberty to appear through video conferencing on the next date of hearing by using the link of this court i.e. <https://dhcdja.webex.com/meet/dja.dhc.vc4>.

5. The registry is further directed to annex the copy of the aforesaid TDR alongwith the court notice.

6. Learned counsel for respondent No.1 sought adjournment to record the



statement of respondent No.1 on the next date of hearing.

7. Renotify on 08.05.2026. Dasti as well.

8. In the meanwhile, Registrar (B&A) is directed to furnish report containing calculation with regard to principal and interest amount payable to the respondents.
