I.A. 8353/2026 (under Section 151 CPC seeking exemption from filing original/certified/dim/illegible/true type copy of annexures and documents)

1. This is an application seeking exemption from filing original/certified/dim/illegible/true type copy of annexures and documents. Original documents shall be produced/filed, if sought, strictly as per the provisions of DHC (Original Side) Rules, 2018.

2. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

3. The application is disposed of

4. The plaint be registered as suit.

5. On filing of process fee, summons be issued to the defendant by all



permissible modes.

6. The summons shall indicate that written statement must be filed within thirty days from the date of receipt of summons. The defendant shall also file an affidavit of admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiff, failing which the written statement shall not be taken on record.

7. The plaintiff is at liberty to file replication thereto within thirty days after filing of the written statement. The replication shall be accompanied by affidavit of admission/denial in respect of the documents filed by the defendant, failing which the replication shall not be taken on record.

8. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.

9. Any party seeking inspection of documents may do so in accordance with the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.

10. List before the learned Joint Registrar for completion of service, pleadings, admission/denial of documents and marking of exhibits on 22.07.2026.

11. List before Court for framing of issues on the date to be assigned by learned Joint Registrar.

I.A. 8352/2026 (under Order XXXIX Rules 1 & 2 read with Section 151 CPC seeking ex-parte ad interim injunction)

12. Issue notice. Notice be served upon the defendant by all permissible modes.

13. The defendant may file reply to the application within a period of four weeks.

14. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a period of two weeks thereafter.



15. The prayer for interim relief will be considered after the service is complete.

16. Re-notify on 16.04.2026.
