1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. Application is disposed of.

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3. The petitioner is seeking initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for the wilful defiance of the directions contained in the order dated 29.10.2024 in OMP(I)(COMM) NO. 14/2024, passed by this Court as also subsequent undertaking given on their behalf in the arbitration proceedings for the payment of rent, electricity, and water charges.

4. No one is present for the respondents despite sending advance notice.

5. Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner has alluded to the order dated 29.10.2024 passed by this Court, whereby, based on the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents that they were ready and willing to make payment of the lease rental, the respondents were directed to clear the arrears by way of a demand



draft in favour of the petitioner within six weeks from the date of learned Arbitrator entered reference.

6. It is further pointed out that the matter came up before the learned Arbitrator on 16.12.2024 and 07.02.2025 and on both dates, although learned counsel for the respondents reiterated that the arrears would be cleared, and there were specific directions to that effect by the learned Arbitrator, the said orders have not been complied with.

7. Issue notice of the present contempt petition to the respondents by all permissible modes. Notice be also issued to the counsels for the respondents appearing in the arbitration proceedings.

8. Re-notify on 22.05.2025.
