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1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking a direction to the respondents to release her up to date arrears of salary as per the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission (CPC) which was binding on the respondent school.
2. Though the respondent school has filed a counter affidavit, the counter affidavit, however, does not reflect whether compliance of the recommendations of the 7th CPC has been done by the school. The respondent nos. 1 & 2 are, therefore, granted three weeks' time to file an affidavit clearly stating as to whether the petitioner has been paid all her dues as per the recommendations of the 7th CPC. A break up of the amounts already paid to the petitioner will also be furnished



alongwith the affidavit. Response thereto, if any, be filed by the petitioner within two weeks.
