Perusal of record shows that an application moved on behalf of the petitioner under Order XXXIII CPC to sue as an indigent person has been filed alongwith the petition, however, the said IA does not bear any number. **Let a Report be called from the Registry in this regard, before the next date of hearing.**

As per record, reply filed on behalf of respondent no.1 to 4 to the application moved on behalf of the petitioner under Order XXXIII CPC to sue as an indigent person and rejoinder thereto filed on behalf of the petitioner, are already on record. **Thus, pleadings qua respondent no.1 to 4 are complete.**

Further, as per record, reply to the above said application under Order XXXIII CPC has been filed on behalf of the respondent no.5&6, however, rejoinder to the



same has not been filed by the petitioner till date. In the interest of justice, the last and final opportunity is granted to the petitioner to file rejoinder to the reply of respondent no.5&6, if any, within one week from today with copy to the opposite side.

At this stage, it is apprised by learned counsel for the petitioner that the Written Statement to the main suit has not been filed by defendants. However, the respective counsels for the defendants submit that the same has been filed. Let the needful be done, as necessitated, as per law, before the next date of hearing.
