I.A. 2613/2026 (Seeking shifting of seized goods by Local Commissioner)

1. This is an application under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 filed on behalf of the defendant seeking shifting of seized goods by the Local Commissioner from TDI City near Sukh Asan Chowk, Faridpur Road Panipat, Haryana to the present premises of the defendant at Khasra No.69//11/2 Village Jatal near the Government School, Panipat Haryana-132103.

2. Issue notice.

3. Notice is accepted by Mr. Krtin Bhasin, learned counsel for the plaintiff. He has no objection in case the application is allowed, however, states that the defendant be directed to file an affidavit in support of such transfer of the goods from the previous premises to the present premises.

4. Mr. Rishub Kapoor, learned counsel for the defendant submits that the goods which were seized by the Local Commissioner were kept in previous premises i.e. TDI City near Sukh Asan Chowk, Faridpur Road Panipat, Haryana, however, the defendant has shifted to the present premises located at Khasra No.69//11/2 Village Jatal near the Government School, Panipat



Haryana-132103. As such, the shifting of the seized goods has become necessary.

5. In view of the aforesaid submissions as also keeping in view the averments made in the application, the application is allowed.

6. The learned counsel for the defendant seeks and is granted one week time to transfer the seized goods from the previous premises i.e. TDI City near Sukh Asan Chowk, Faridpur Road Panipat, Haryana to the present premises i.e. Khasra No.69//11/2 Village Jatal near the Government School, Panipat Haryana-132103.

7. An affidavit shall be filed by the learned counsel for the defendant giving clear details of the goods which have been shifted alongwith photographs of the seized goods. The affidavit be filed within two weeks.

8. An authorized representative of the plaintiff is permitted to be present the time when the seized goods are being shifted. The defendant shall intimate the plaintiff of such transfer atleast 48 hours in advance by a written communication as also by Whatsapp.

9. The application is disposed of.
