I.A. 11086/2025 and I.A. 11087/2025

1. I.A. 11086/2025 is an Application filed on behalf of the Defendant under Order XXXIX Rule 4 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, ("CPC") seeking vacation of the *ex-parte* order dated 11.03.2025 and I.A. 11087/2025 is an Application filed on behalf of the Defendant under Section 151 of the CPC for release of the goods seized.
2. However, these Applications incorrectly mention the date of the order as 04.03.2025 instead of 11.03.2025.
3. The learned Counsel for the Defendant seeks to withdraw these Applications as I.A. 15684/2025 has already been filed mentioning the correct date of the order.
4. In view of the same, these Applications are dismissed as withdrawn.



I.A. 15684/2025 (for vacation of *ex-parte* injunction order)

5. This is an Application filed on behalf of the Defendant under Order XXXIX Rule 4 read with Section 151 of the CPC, seeking vacation / modification of the order dated 11.03.2025.

6. Issue Notice. The learned Counsel for the Plaintiff accepts Notice and seeks time to file Reply to this Application.

7. Let the Reply be filed within a period of for weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a period of two weeks thereafter.

I.A. 18073/2025 (for condonation of delay)

8. This is an Application filed under Order VIII Rule 1 read with Section 151 of the CPC seeking condonation of delay of 35 days in filing the Written Statement and the list of documents.

9. The learned Counsel for the Plaintiff submits that although the Application mentions the delay of 35 days, in fact the delay is more than 35 days. However, the Plaintiff does not have any objection if the delay in filing the Written Statement and the list of documents is condoned.

10. Accordingly, for the reasons mentioned in the Application and considering the submissions made before this Court, the delay in filing the Written Statement and the list of documents is condoned.

11. The Application is disposed of.
