1. By this appeal, the appellant challenges the impugned judgment dated 23rd March, 2019 passed by the Family Court, Dwarka New Delhi whereby the appeal filed by the appellant under Section 13(1)(1a) and 13(1)(1b) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 was dismissed.
2. Learned counsel for the appellant states that since there was ample material on record to show that despite the parties have a minor



daughter, the respondent never adhered to pay maintenance and rather in the affidavit filed he claimed that a minor daughter was not dependent on her as also stated further incorrect facts, the learned trial Court ignoring all these facts dismissed the petition filed by the appellant.
