1. It is stated by learned counsel for the defendant that he will pay cost of Rs.20,000/- to learned counsel for the plaintiff within one week. He further submits that previously also he tendered the said cost to the previous counsel but the same was not accepted by him due to engaged of new counsel.

2. It is stated by learned counsel for the plaintiff that she will file fresh Vakalatnama on behalf of the plaintiff shortly. Let needful be done as stated. She further submits that she has not received copy of Written Statement filed by the defendant from the previous counsel of plaintiff and requests that the defendant may be directed to supply the same again to her. It is stated by learned counsel for the defendant that he will supply the same within two days through email. Let needful be done as stated.

3. On perusal of the Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by the defendant, it is found that the same is not in the prescribed format. So, the defendant is directed to file fresh/proper Affidavit of Admission/Denial



of the documents in the prescribed format as per Chapter VII of Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules within two weeks with copy to the opposite side.

4. As per record, it is found that the Written Statement filed by the defendant is not on record. So, the defendant is directed to take appropriate steps to bring Written Statement on record as per law.

5. On receipt of copy of fresh Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents and copy of Written Statement from the defendant, the plaintiff is directed to file Replication to the same within stipulated period with copy to the opposite side.

6. Thereafter, the plaintiff is directed to file soft copy as well as physical copy of Joint Schedule of the documents at least two weeks before the next date of hearing with copy to the opposite side.

7. Re-notify the matter for marking of exhibits to the documents on 24.09.2024.
