1. The right of defendant no.2,3&4 to file Written Statement has already been ordered to be forfeited.
2. The plaintiff has filed fresh Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents.
3. As per office note, revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by defendant no.1 is lying under objections. Learned counsel for the defendant no.1 seeks one more opportunity to bring it on record. Opposed.
4. Heard and record perused. Vide order dated 27.02.2025, the defendant no.1 was given last and final opportunity to revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents within three weeks subject to filing of medical documents of defendant no.1. So, the defendant no.1 had ample time to revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents. Despite the same the medical documents of defendant no.1 has not been filed. Even, the revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by defendant no.1 is lying under



objections. No plausible explanation is furnished by learned counsel for the defendant no.1 for non compliance of the last order. In the interest of justice and subject to imposition of cost of Rs.3000/- upon the defendant no.1 to be deposited with Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee, one more last and final opportunity is granted to the defendant no.1 to take requisite steps to bring revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents on record within two weeks. The defendant no.1 is also directed to file medical documents in compliance of the last order dated 27.02.2025 within two weeks.

5. It is stated by learned counsel for the plaintiff that he has not received copy of said revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by defendant no.1, to which learned counsel for the defendant no.1 undertakes to supply the same within one week through email.

6. Thereafter, the plaintiff is directed to share draft of Joint Schedule of the documents with learned counsels for the defendants within three weeks. Learned counsels for defendants are directed to either provide their inputs, if any, to the draft of Joint Schedule of the documents or to provide the signed copy of Joint Schedule of the documents to learned counsel for the plaintiff within two weeks thereafter. The plaintiff is directed to file soft copy as well as physical copy of Joint Schedule of the documents within one week thereafter with copy to the opposite side.

7. Both the parties are directed to file physical copy of the documents of which e-copy already filed on record, if



not filed earlier, before the next date of hearing, failing which the defaulting party will deposit cost of Rs.2000/- with Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee.

Re-notify the matter for marking of exhibits to the documents on 12.09.2025.
