CS(OS) 176/2021

1. The right of defendant no.2,3&4 to file Written Statement has already been ordered to be forfeited.
2. As per record, fresh Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents has been filed on behalf of the plaintiff.
3. As per office note, revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by defendant no.1 is still lying under objections and even the previous cost of Rs. 3000/-, imposed upon the defendant no.1 to be deposited with Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee, remains unpaid. Necessary steps be undertaken by defendant no. 1 for removal of the objections and bringing the revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of documents on record, before the next date of hearing positively. The defendant no. 1 is also directed to file the proof of the previous cost of Rs.3,000/- with the Registry, before the next date of hearing.
4. As per record, the defendant no.1 has still not filed the medical documents in compliance of previous order



dated 27.02.2025. Let the same be filed before the next date of hearing positively.

5. As per office note, the plaintiff has not been filed the Joint Schedule of documents. After service of the copy of the Revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of documents of the defendant no. 1, the plaintiff is directed to share draft of Joint Schedule of the documents with learned counsels for the defendant/(s) within three weeks. Learned counsels for defendants are directed to either provide their inputs, if any, to the draft of Joint Schedule of the documents or to provide the signed copy of Joint Schedule of the documents to learned counsel for the plaintiff within two weeks thereafter. The plaintiff is directed to file soft copy as well as physical copy of Joint Schedule of the documents within one week thereafter with copy to the opposite side.

6. The parties are directed to file physical copy of the documents of which e-copy already filed on record, if not filed earlier, before the next date of hearing, failing which the defaulting party will deposit cost of Rs.2000/- with Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee.

7. Re-notify the matter for Admission/Denial of documents on 27.03.2026.
