W.P.(C) 4757/2023 & CM APPL. 18346/2023 (for interim directions)

1. By way of this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution, the petitioner has challenged various Annual Confidential Reports ["ACR"]/Annual Performance Appraisal Report ["APAR"] gradings given to him, and also raised the contention that he was entitled to promotion from E-1 grade to E-2 grade since the year 2019, whereas he was granted promotion only from 01.07.2021.
2. It is not possible to hear the writ petition finally today, but Dr. B.T. Kaul, learned counsel for the petitioner, seeks to press CM APPL. 18346/2023 for an interim direction that the petitioner's case for promotion be considered in the forthcoming Departmental Promotion



Committee [“DPC”] in June-July, 2025 from E-2 grade to E-3 grade.

3. It is made clear that pendency of this writ petition will not come in the way of the petitioner being considered in the forthcoming DPC, if he meets the eligibility condition in terms of the promotion policy.

4. In view of the above, CM APPL. 18346/2023 stands disposed of.
