The hearing has been conducted through hybrid mode (physical and virtual hearing).

CM APPL. 2808/2021 (By petitioner for early hearing)

1. For the reasons mentioned in the application , it is allowed.
2. The application stands disposed-off.

CM APPL. 7142/2020 (By petitioner for early hearing)

3. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
4. The application stands disposed-off.

CONT.CAS(C) 154/2020

5. The learned counsel for the petitioner-father submits that the mother is in breach of the directions regarding visitation rights. The respondent-mother submits that the father was directed to pay an amount of Rs.30,000/- per month in terms of the order dated 24.04.2019 passed by the learned trial court. The said order was



impugned before this court and the appeal received a prompt dismissal. The petitioner has not complied with the said directions and the outstanding amounts are in the range of Rs.7,28,000/-. The court is prima facie, of the view that the father himself is in breach of the aforesaid court's directions, which are primarily meant for the maintenance of the mother and the children. There can be no dispute that till such time the aforesaid directions for payments is not altered, the petitioner-father is bound to pay the monies.

6. The father has not interacted with his children for about two years now. To begin with, the parties agree that the father will interact with the children through video-call at 5:00 p.m this evening. Such interactions between the father and the children will continue at the option of the children, anytime of the day and any day of the week. Furthermore, physical interaction will also take place this Saturday i.e. 19.02.2022, from 10:30 a.m to 4:00 p.m. The father shall pick up the children from the mother's house. Since the children have not met their father for quite some time, the mother will prepare them for the meeting. The learned counsel for the parties assure the court that they will facilitate the process and if feasible also be present during the said interaction at the ASI Park next to Sunder Nursery. The mother also may be in the vicinity, if she so desires. The payment of their refreshments will be taken care of by the father. Similar visitations be repeated on 19.02.2022 and 26.02.2022.



7. In the interim, the father will deposit an amount of Rs.1,20,000/- in the mother's bank account by Friday, i.e. 18.02.2022.
