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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.

2. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions. The application is disposed of.

CM APPL. 48642/2025 (Direction)

3. The present application under Section 151 of the CPC seeks the following prayers:

“a. Allow the present Application and issue time-bound directions to the Respondents/Contemnors to strictly comply with the Judgment dated 23.05.2017 passed in Writ Petition (C) No. 11645 of 2016 titled Sadar Bazar Traders Association (Regd.) v. North Municipal Corporation of Delhi & Ors., and subsequent orders dated 08.03.2021 and 10.03.2021 in Contempt Case (C) No. 914/2019, Order dated 01.10.2021 in Contempt Case (C) No. 729/2021, and Orders dated 20.10.2022, 25.11.2022, and 22.12.2022 in the present contempt petition, and take immediate



remedial actions for the hawkers/ squatters;

b. Direct the Respondents, to file compliance affidavits, as directed by in the previous Orders passed by this Hon'ble Court.

c. Such other orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem just, fit and expedient to be granted in favour of the petitioner.”

4. Issue notice.

5. Learned counsel for respondent no. 4 accepts notice. Let an updated status report be filed before the next date of hearing.

6. On the applicant taking necessary steps, issue notice to respondent nos. 1 to 3 through all permissible modes, including electronic mail, if any, returnable on 11.09.2025.

7. In the meantime, on the applicant approaching the Special Task Force, the latter shall take necessary steps in accordance with law.

8. Order be uploaded on the website of this Court, *forthwith*.
