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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner/applicant submits that, in terms of order dated 08.08.2025, they had approached the STF and the encroachments by hawkers were removed on 28.08.2025, however, the hawkers have re-encroached the area again. In pursuance of the notice issued vide order dated 08.08.2025, learned counsel enters appearance on behalf of respondent nos. 1 to 3 and submits that he shall file an updated status report with respect to the actions taken by the concerned respondents till date. Let the same be done.
3. It has come on record by various status reports that despite action being taken



by the MCD, including the STF, there are regular encroachments in the area.

4. In these circumstances, this Court deems it appropriate to direct respondent nos. 1 to 3 to conduct a weekly drive in order to ensure the compliance of order dated 23.05.2017 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in W.P.(C) 11645/2016.

5. The report of the weekly drive shall be submitted to the STF.

6. Let an updated status report be filed by the MCD before the next date of hearing.

7. List on the date already fixed i.e. 08.10.2025.
