11. Accordingly, let a new team be constituted by the respondent nos. 1 to 3, and information with regard thereto shall be given to learned counsel for the petitioner.
12. At this stage, learned counsel for the respondent-Municipal Corporation of Delhi (“MCD”) submits that, in terms of the last order of this Court, a Status Report has been filed yesterday, i.e., 19th August, 2026.
13. Accordingly, let steps be taken to have the same placed on record.
